ART-AID: Basel Project for Japan challenges perceptions of disaster, with a particular emphasis upon the Great East Japan Earthquake of 3/11. The exhibition presents the works of artists who share a deep connection to Japan and a desire to contribute to its renewal. The project is part of an effort to raise scholarship funds for children, especially those who lost their parents as a result of the disaster. As of April 2011, over 27,000 people are dead or missing in the Tohoku region. However, for the survivors, the task of re-building and healing scars begins. This exhibition, along with the messages received at the event and planned outreach projects will support the process of recovery.
